	<p>Indication 1)</p> <p>Traditional herbal medicinal product used for the relief of symptoms of common cold.</p> <p>Indication 2)</p> <p>Traditional herbal medicinal product for the relief of mild symptoms of mental stress.</p> <p>The product is a traditional herbal medicinal product for use in specified indications exclusively based upon long-standing use.</p>

4.2. Posology and method of administration³

	<p>Posology</p> <p><i>Adolescents, Adults and Elderly</i></p> <p>a) Comminuted herbal substance</p> <p>Single dose</p> <p>Herbal tea: 1.5 g of the comminuted herbal substance in 150 ml of boiling water as a herbal infusion 2–4 times daily.</p> <p>b) Liquid extract</p> <p>Single dose 2 ml 1-2 times daily</p> <p>Daily dose 2-4 ml</p> <p>c) Tincture</p> <p>Single dose 1 ml 1-2 times daily</p> <p>Daily dose 1-2 ml</p> <p>The use in children under 12 years of age is not recommended (see section 4.4 'Special warnings and precautions for use').</p>

4.4. Special warnings and precautions for use

	<p data-bbox="810 1308 1422 1373">The use in children under 12 years of age has not been established due to lack of adequate data.</p> <p data-bbox="810 1402 967 1429">Indication 1)</p> <p data-bbox="810 1458 1385 1632">If the symptoms worsen during the use of the medicinal product or if dyspnoea, high fever or purulent sputum occurs, a doctor or a qualified health care practitioner should be consulted immediately.</p> <p data-bbox="810 1662 1430 1834">For tinctures and extracts containing ethanol, the appropriate labelling for ethanol, taken from the 'Guideline on excipients in the label and package leaflet of medicinal products for human use', must be included.</p>
